International award of Piano performance "Lillina Condemi", 20 – 35 age

The tryout

The tryout has the duration of not more than 25 minutes and consists in performing:

- 1) Prelude and fugue by J. Bach (adapted from "The well-tempered Clavier);
- 2) A one study by F. Chopin; or F. Liszt, or C. Debussy or by A. Skrjabin, or by S. Rachmaninov;
- 3) A piece of music chosen by the candidate;

The final round

Solo (maximum duration of 40 minutes): free choice by the candidates, with music pieces adapted from the Romantic, Impressionist and Modern music repertoire.

THE TRYOUT

The tryout has the duration of not more than 25 minutes and consists in performing:

- 1. A piece of Marimba (chosen by the candidate)
- 2. A piece of Vibraphone (chosen by the candidate)
- 3. A piece of Timpani (chosen by the candidate)
- 4. A piece of Drum (chosen by the candidate)

The pieces must be in a virtuous character

THE FINAL ROUND

Section 4 – Chamber music – Middle school (Music School)

- Cat. A from 2 to 6 elements (students attending 1st, 2nd, 3rd grade middle school) 7 minutes
- Cat. B from 7 to 20 elements (students attending 1st, 2nd, 3rd grade middle school) 10 minutes
- Cat. C 21 elements and over (students attending 1st, 2nd, 3rd grade middle school) 15 minutes

Section 5 – Chamber music Middle School (Musical Education)

Cat. A – duration 15 minutes

The schools participating to Sections 3 and 4 must provide to bring all the necessary equipment and material for their performances. The organization will make available a piano, 10 music stands and the general amplifying system with omnidirectional microphone.

TIME IN MINUTES

Art. 1 The time limit set for the musical pieces for each category does not oblige the candidates to having to achieve it, while provision should be made for the Commission to interrupt the performance in case the candidates should exceed the set time limit.

THE SCORE

Art. 2 The score is attributed according to the average calculated from the sum of the marks expressed by each component the commission, excluding the highest mark and the lowest.

Art. 4 The candidates can avail a trustworthy pianist of theirs. The performance of the accompanying pianist will not be subject to evaluation by the Commission.

REHEARSAL AND COMMISSION

- **Art. 5** Each candidate, before starting the examination, has to submit a valid identification document and put at disposal the photocopy of the musical pieces presented.
- **Art. 6** The commission, whose nomination is reserved to the organizing academy, is composed of music school teachers, well known people in the music field, music critics, composers and musicians of the highest repute. The voting is expressed in hundredths and will be made known at the end of the examination of each section. The judgement of the commission cannot be appealable.
- **Art. 7** The subscription of the application to participate implies unconditional acceptance of the regulation governing the competition.
- **Art. 8** The candidates are allowed to subscribe to a higher category than the one corresponding to their age.
- **Art. 9** The organization reserves to take photos and to record audio/videos of everything or part of the performance during the Competition available for dissemination, without owing any compensation to the candidates.

Art. 10 There will not be taken responsibilities of risks and damages of whichever nature that might derive to the candidates during the whole Competition.

Art. 11 The organization reserves the right to make those changes to this regulation which would make it necessary for a better result of the competition. It is entitled to cancel the competition if reasons independent from their will shall prevent the performance, in that case the entry fee will be reimbursed to the registered candidates.
